Know Where to Go When Severe Weather Strikes

We love summer in Minnesota - from camping and fishing to sports and more, we spend a lot of our summer outdoors. But hot and muggy temps increase the chance of getting caught outside when thunderstorms hit.

Even if the sky seems clear, lightning can travel up to 10 miles from the storm and strike "out of the blue." Remember: if you hear thunder, you are close enough to be struck by lightning. Time to stop what you are doing and seek shelter immediately.

Fast Facts About Lightning Fatalities

According to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), lightning kills an average of 35 people per year, with the most deaths occurring between June and August. Two thirds of lightning fatalities occur during outdoor leisure activities:

- Fishing and other water activities account for nearly 20% of all lightning fatalities, with fishing as the number one activity associated with lightning deaths.
- Men account for nearly 80% of lightning deaths.
- 70% of fatalities occur in June, July and August, the peak time for both lightning and outdoor activities. July is by far the deadliest month.
- Most victims are between the age of 10 and 59. Of that group, people age 20-29 account for the most fatalities and age 30-39 the least.

Free Online Classes - The Arc Minnesota

Are you a person with a disability who self-directs your own life and services? Are you a family member or guardian who hires direct support professionals for a loved one with a disability? If you answered "yes" to either of these questions, you might be interested in taking advantage of The Arc Minnesota's new partnership with the University of Minnesota's DirectCourse to provide online, customizable training classes free of charge.

DirectCourse offers more than 40 training programs that improve service practices and quality of life outcomes in support of people with disabilities. The training curricula are built on the fundamental principle that everyone deserves a rich and rewarding life.

The online training available through DirectCourse increase the knowledge and skills of support professionals, family members, other caregivers, and community members who are crucial to promoting community inclusion and individual safety, as well as increased involvements in education, community living, recreation, employment and other outcomes important to people with disabilities.

The Arc Minnesota is partnering with the University of Minnesota and DirectCourse to provide educational outreach and enrollment assistance to Minnesota families, people with disabilities and other community members to inform them of these **free**, self-paced and customizable training opportunities.

Courses are now available through four online colleges including:

- The College of Direct Support
- The College of Personal Assistance and Caregiving
- The College of Employment Services
- The College of Recovery and Community Inclusion.
