Out of state travel: Please call the office and notify us of out of state travel and if a PCA will be traveling with a client.

Out of country travel: PCA's are not permitted to work with a client if traveling outside of the USA.



Get ready to vote!!!

Voters will cast ballots in two state elections in 2022. The primary election is Tuesday, August 9th. The general election is Tuesday, November 8th.

Voters can cast their ballot in one of three ways—in person, with an absentee ballot or by early voting.

You can cast your ballot at the polling place on Election Day. Voting hours are 7 a.m.—8 p.m.

Vote by absentee ballot by requesting one, completing it according to the enclosed instructions and returning it in the envelopes provided. Absentee ballots must arrive by Election Day. Absentee voting started June 24th for the primary election.

Early voting for the primary election is available August 2nd-9th. You can cast your ballot and feed it directly into a ballot counter at your city hall.

To find your polling place, register to vote, check your registration and/or apply for an absentee ballot, go to: www.mnvotes.org. To apply to be an election judge, contact your city/township office.
